## **Camp Mataponi Terms & Conditions**

**Financial Arrangements:** Make all checks payable to: Camp Mataponi. With each child's application please enclose a deposit of **\$2,000.00**. An additional **\$1,500.00** is due **December 1 and February 1**, and the remainder is due **April 30**. Deposits are fully refundable until August 31, 2011. Any child canceling between September 1 and November 30, 2011 will receive a refund minus \$500.00. This is a non-refundable registration fee, which covers the basic administrative cost of the enrollment. After December 1, no money will be refunded. There can be no exceptions. Refunds are made twice a year: once on May 1<sup>st</sup> and the other on September 30<sup>th</sup>. Please note there is an added 3% fee for credit card payments.

**Any payments received after the due date shall forfeit any tuition discount offered. Tuition will automatically increase to the full amount.**

**No child** will be permitted to attend camp if full tuition is not paid by June 1<sup>st</sup>. There is **no** reduction in tuition for those children leaving early. Camp Mataponi reserves the right to change the opening and closing dates of its camp season if necessary. Return of the camping deposit shall release Camp Mataponi from all liability of enrollment. All Camp fees shall be paid in US dollars.

**Health:** Prescription medications will be billed to the parents. The Camp shall not be responsible for any injuries that may be sustained by your child while participating in any activity at Camp unless such injury is directly caused by the gross negligence or willful acts of the Camp. The Camp will not be responsible for the personal health and well being of children whose health forms are not submitted prior to the arrival of the child at Camp.

**Permission to Provide Necessary Treatment or Emergency Care:** I hereby give permission to the medical personnel selected by the camp director to order X-rays, routine tests, treatment; to release any records necessary for insurance purposes; and to provide or arrange necessary related transportation for me/or my child. In the event I cannot be reached in an emergency, I hereby give permission to the physician selected by the camp director to secure and administer treatment, including hospitalization, for the person named above. This completed form, excluding payment details, may be photocopied for trips out of camp.

It is further understood that the Camp has the right to use any pictures taken at Camp for the purpose of promoting Camper enrollment and/or advertising the camp. This agreement gives your child permission to participate in all activities while at Camp this summer, including but not limited to horseback riding, gymnastics, and field sport programs. Not included in tuition: Medical insurance, extra horseback riding, private tennis, tutoring, travel to camp, and baggage transportation.

As members of the American Camping Association, we do not permit tipping. Camp Mataponi counselors understand this standard and agree to adhere to it in their contracts. Camp families agree that no deductions are to be made from the tuition for a camper arriving late, leaving early or missing any portion of the camp season. Also, no refunds are to be made for campers dismissed for misconduct or disciplinary reasons. Reoccurring misconduct and illegal acts (such as using non-prescription drugs, smoking, and consuming alcoholic beverages) are prohibited. Violations of these prohibitions, as well as any other non-conforming or illegal behavior, constitutes ground for dismissal from Camp.

**Valuables:** Camp is responsible for cash or valuables including passports and tickets that have been brought to the safe. Money given to your child should be deposited directly with the camp. There is no need for campers to have money in their cabin at any time. The office will determine how much spending money is needed for special trips and will issue "envelope money" amounts when necessary. Camp Mataponi recommends that no valuable items such as watches, rings, expensive cameras etc. be brought to camp.

**Clothing & Equipment:** The Camp has minimal required uniforms. The suggested clothing and equipment list should be closely followed. Camp Mataponi is not responsible for clothing sent to the Camp laundry, luggage lost in shipment to and from Camp, or for clothing and equipment lost in Camp or on trips. Do not send expensive clothing to Camp. All clothing and personal items must be labeled with the camper's name. There is no dry cleaning service so all clothing should be wash and wear.
